С	Moderate	Significant injury or physical illness requiring hospitalisation; mental illness requiring treatment; lost time injury < 1 week.	3	Possible	Risk might occur at some time; once every 5 – 20 years.	
D	Minor	Injury or physical illness requiring medical treatment; mental illness requiring treatment; not a lost time injury.	2	Unlikely	Risk is unlikely to occur; once every 20 – 50 years.
